### **BOARD UPDATE**

With the economic downturn and the unstable state of the world this has been a challenging time for us the Board members and the co-op. With the increases in the costs of goods and services, trying to maintain a balanced budget and keeping maintenance costs affordable is a big task.



Also, we know it's been extremely difficult for some residents because of loss of jobs, cut back in salaries and health issues, we endeavor to do our best in keeping cost at a minimum. Hopefully, things will turn around soon.

### **HEATING OIL**

Heating oil costs continue to be one of the most challenging areas of our budget. So far for 2009, we've spent \$412,000 compared to \$505,000 for 2008 and \$425,000 for the previous year. Management does their best to keep cost at a minimum by purchasing fuel at a favorable market cost.



### **INSURANCE COST**

Laurelton Gardens Cooperative renewed its annual coop insurance in November 2009 at the same cost of \$137,000 even though a claim was submitted and paid.

### **COST CONTROL**

We try to control cost as best we can, so as not to increase maintenance fees, but it's expenses such as water and sewer taxes, real estate taxes and heating costs we have no control over. All these costs continue to increase, but we'll do our best to keep costs down by cutting from other areas where we see fit.

**NOTE:** The water and sewer bills for each quarter last year exceeded \$20,000.00
